

PRIEST: Christ, the Eternal Light, Son and the Word of the Father, Who in the end of days manifested from the womb of the Virgin by a law that is beyond nature as Savior and Redeemer for us, who were formerly 'sitting in darkness and in the shadows of death'9, By the foreknowledge, You commanded to come up a spring, divided into four rivers to water the face of the earth. At the end of days, You covered the borders of the earth by the 'flow' of the preaching of the Gospel. By the mortal waters, you have put an end to the pride of the wicked with justice. Like the rain upon the fleece, You descended on the listeners of the divine knowledge and covered the seas. By striking with a rod, You divided the Red Sea, and made the people who were running hastily toward the promised land to cross as on dry land. You cast the stubborn Pharaoh and his armies into the depths of the sea. You have set us free from the oppression of the demons as if from the greatly troubled waves of the sea. From the rock, You gave water to the people who were thirsty, by the hand of Your servant Moses. You are the true rock that brings forth rivers of life from within the bodies of those who believe in You. O Lord, by the wood that was put in the waters, You changed the bitter taste into sweetness. On the venerable cross, by the blood and water which came forth from Your holy side, You purified the gentiles. By the prayer of the prophet and by salt, You made the sterile waters of Jericho wholesome¹⁰, and symbolized Your decent into Jordan. By Your baptism, the font saving us from spiritual destruction, You granted rebirth that resembles Your divinity.

> Now O Lord, by the threefold invocation of the three Lights that are beyond the world, make these waters that are placed before us the waters that multiply joy. Make these waters, 'the waters of rest', the purification of all defilements of sin, healing for souls and bodies,

BLESSING OF THE WATER

DEACON: Barekmor. Stoumen kalos.

- **PEOPLE:** Kurielaison.
- O Great and Glorious God, Who is beyond glory; Who is PRIEST: carried by the cherubim and is glorified by the seraphim; Who performed innumerable great things and wondrous and indescribable signs; Who sweetened the bitter waters at the hand of Moses with the wood typifying the sign of the Cross, and Who gave water to the thirsty people of Israel to drink; Who healed the barren, sterile, and bad waters by the visible salt which Elishah the prophet cast in the spring of water in Jericho, and to Your people, who became fruitful and multiplied and filled the earth, this was in anticipation of Your mystery, Christ God, the Heavenly Salt. As the Maker and Founder of all things, by Your ineffable wisdom You changed the substance of water into good wine at Cana of Galilee, and You sanctified the abundance of the Jordan when You were baptized by John the Baptist. Even now, O Lord, by the blessing of the spiritual and heavenly Salt, by Your invisible mighty power, by Your ineffable lovingkindness, and by the descent of Your Holy Spirit, bless (†) these waters that are set before us. Send to them the grace, the power, and the priestly operation of Your Holy Spirit, that they may be unto all who take from them or participate in them, the gift of divine healing of their souls, bodies, and spirits. To You be glory, honor, and dominion, with Your blessed Father and Your Holy Spirit, now and forever.

- **PRIEST:** O Creator of the waters and Maker and Changer of all things, bless (†) these waters by the power of Your Holy Spirit and grant to them grace and power against all opposing forces, and grant to all those who participate in them by drinking or sprinkling or by any other means, healing of soul and body and rich mercies from You, removal from all evil, and salvation and peace for our life by Your grace, O Lord Jesus Christ, and of Your Father and of Your Holy Spirit, all holy, good, adorable, and life-giving, Who is of one substance with You, now and forever.
- **PEOPLE:** Amin.
- **PRIEST:** † Peace be unto you all.
- **PEOPLE:** And to your spirit.

The priest removes the veil which covers the vesse and waves his hand gently over it and over the cross. Then he removes the cross from the mouth of the vessel, while one of the deacons says the following admonition.

- DEACON: Let us stand well, let us stand with fear, with modesty, with purity, and with holiness. Let us stand, my brethren, in love and true faith and fix our minds upon these waters that are set before us and are blessed by the *reverend priest*.* In peace and tranquility, let us offer prayers and supplications to God, the Lord of all, that He may be pleased to bless them.
- **PEOPLE:** Grant us, O Lord, mercy, peace and the blessing of these waters.
- **PRIEST:** *Hoobo...*† The Love of God, the Father, † the grace of the Only-begotten Son, † and the fellowship and indwelling of the Holy Spirit be with you all, my brethren, forever.

The priest, with outstretched hands, says the following prayer

How great you are, O Lord, and how marvelous Your PRIEST: works are. It is beyond the speech of mortals to speak of the perfection of Your wondrous signs. Your creative power brought everything into being from nothing. By Your dominion You sustain creation, and by Your providence You support the world. You have joined together the four elements and crowned the cycle of the year with the four seasons. The incorporeal heavenly hosts tremble at Your presence; the angelic ranks glorify You; the companies of the archangels worship You; the six-winged seraphim, as they fly, praise You; the manyeved cherubim, with unapproachable glory, bless You; the sun, the moon, the stars, and the light, in their courses, declare Your works; the depths fled at Your rebuke; the springs perform Your service. You stretched out the heavens like a curtain; You spread forth the earth above the waters; You set the sand as a boundary to the sea; and You spread the air for breathing. You are the incomprehensible, eternal, and ineffable God Who was beheld on the earth, taking upon Yourself the image of a slave and the likeness of man, because Your compassion could not suffer to behold our human race harnessed under the voke of the adversary; therefore, You came down and redeemed us. We praise Your loving-kindness. We proclaim Your mercies and we acknowledge Your wondrous visitation to us. You bless our natural birth. and by Your birth in the flesh, You sanctified the virginal womb. The whole creation glorified in Your manifestation, for You are our God Who was seen on earth and went about with men. You sanctified the abundance of the River Jordan by sending upon it from heaven Your Holy Spirit; and You crushed the head of the dragon who Do then, compassionate Lord, by the lurked there. descent of Your Holy Spirit, come and bless these waters (†); bestow upon them the grace of the Jordan (†); make them the fountains of blessings (†); the gifts of holiness (†); the forgiveness of sins.

- **PRIEST:** For the healing of sickness (†); for the support of the weak (†); unapproachable by the powers of the adversary (†); filled with the Divine Power (†).
- **PEOPLE:** Amin.
- **PRIEST:** Make these waters unto those who receive from them or participate in them for the healing of souls and bodies (†); for the purification of passions (†); for the sanctification of homes (†); for the preservation from all injuries (†).
- **PEOPLE:** Amin.
- **PRIEST:** By water and the Spirit, You have renewed our nature which was corrupted by sin; by the waters You overwhelmed sin in the days of Noah; by the waters of the sea You delivered the Hebrews from the bondage of Pharaoh; by the fire and water of the Prophet Elijah's sacrifice You absolved Israel from the worship of Ba'al. Even now, O Lord, as You bless these waters by Your grace, bestow upon all those who touch them or participate in them or use them in true faith for any purpose, (†) blessings, holiness and purification (†); health, healing and rest to the afflicted (†); and encouragement, aid and freedom from all mental and carnal passions.
- **PEOPLE:** Amin.
- **PRIEST:** So that the whole universe, men, angels, visible and invisible beings, may offer praise to Your most glorious and most blessed Name, O our God, with Your Father and with Your Holy Spirit, both now and forever.

The priest waves his right hand over the vessel and draws on it the sign of the Cross three times, saying:

- **PRIEST:** And of the Holy Spirit (†) for life eternal.

The priest puts back the cross in the mouth of the vessel. He carries it high between his hands. Turning to the East, the priest shall say:

Priest: To the <u>One</u> – fiery hosts praise, **Response:** Holy <u>are</u> – You, O God!___

Priest: To the <u>One</u> – spiritual beings exalt, **Response:** Holy <u>are</u> – You, Al<u>mighty!</u>

Priest: To the <u>One</u> – mortals worship, **Response:** Holy <u>are</u> – You, <u>Immo</u>rtal

Priest: Children of the faithful Church, entreat say`ing:___ **Response:** O Christ, our Lord, who was baptized for our sake,_____ have mercy on us

(Turning to the North)

(Turning to the south)

Priest: Lord, have <u>mercy</u> – upon us **Response**: Lord, be <u>kind</u> – and have <u>mercy</u> **Priest:** Lord, accept our service and our entrea<u>ties;</u>

Have mercy on us

Response: Glory to - You, O God Priest: Glory to - You, Creator Response: Glory to You, Christ the King, Who has mercy_____ upon <u>us sinners...Barekmor</u>.

Our Father, Who art in heaven...

Then the priest, accompanied by the deacons, shall go to the baptistery with the bottle. He shall open the font, remove the cross from the bottle and pour a few drops of the water in the form of a cross over the cross placed in the font. The first time to the East, the second to the West, and the third to the North and South. The people shall recite Psalm 51. Then the clergy and deacons return to the sanctuary and the priest shall put the bottle on the altar. Then he shall say the following prayer:
